The 2013 Janet Rothenberg Memorial meet held January 19 and 20, 2013 and there will be one senior awarded a **\$5,000** scholarship in memory of Janet. The criteria for receiving this scholarship is based on: 1. Academic Excellence, 2. Community Involvement and 3. Athletic Achievement. The nomination of a gymnast for this award should be made by you, her coach. The criteria relates to what was important to Janet during her lifetime.

We are asking you and your athlete to complete the brief application below and submit it to us prior by December 15, 2012.

Eligibility will include and not be limited to the following criteria:

1. Athlete must be a member of the USA Gymnastics Junior Olympic Program (Any Level)
2. Athlete must be in her senior year of high school.
3. Athlete must compete in the 2013 Janet Rothenberg Memorial Meet.
4. A timely completed application must be received by the athlete's coach.

** The recipient will be announced during the meet. A memorial plaque and the scholarship check will be presented at that time. The awardee's name will be added to a perpetual plaque displayed at the United Sports Academy facilities.
